New Culinary Addition and Remodel

MADISON AREA TECHNICAL COLLEGE (MATC)

Madison Area Technical College (MATC) provides a top quality, accredited education for nearly 40,000 students, in and around south-central Wisconsin. An addition and renovation to the training center at the main Truax campus helped MATC expand their program offerings.

Problem

An addition and remodel of Madison Area Technical College's Culinary School was needed to increase enrollment in some degree-seeking programs and expand their offerings for continuing education students.

Additional highlights included a highly visible demonstration kitchen and eight renovation projects.

Solutions

- Worked well with owner and architect changes which affected the compilation of a final bill of materials
- Released lighting fixtures and gear prior to final project approval to keep the project moving forward and meet the expected completion date
- Intense project coordination was key for the overall success of the project
- Successfully managed frequent job specification changes requested by project coordinators
- Released, delivered, and shipped product directly to Forward Electric on the jobsite

Results

- Built three-story facility for culinary, baking, and hospitality programs
- Moved the school's culinary and baking institute to a highly visible downtown location
- Expanded culinary space from 8,500 sq. ft. to nearly 22,000 sq. ft.
- Extended baking space from 2,500 sq. ft. to 6,000 sq. ft., increased workstations from 16 to 20
- Renovated barber and baker training spaces, dining halls, student career services, career services, and student life/lounge areas
